

14th Juried Exhibition High School Seniors: Let your camera be your guide!

Overview

The Griffin Museum of Photography has conducted a Juried Show for several years. This year will be our 14th annual. The Griffin Museum is adding a separate portion to the Juried Show that will just be for high school seniors from specific area towns (see below). In addition one \$1000 scholarship, called the Joan Johnson Scholarship, will be awarded to one high school senior.

Submission

- Students are required to submit one photograph (no minimum, maximum size – 13” x 19”). Submissions must be accompanied by the Griffin Museum Entry Form and checklist.
- There is no fee for submission.
- The student must be a high school senior residing in one of the following cities and towns: Arlington, Bedford, Belmont, Billerica, Burlington, Cambridge, Carlisle, Chelmsford, Concord, Lexington, Lincoln, Malden, Medford, Melrose, Reading, Stoneham, Wakefield, Wilmington, Winchester, Woburn and Medford.
- There is no theme or preferred format for the submission; however the student’s challenge is to select an image that best represents them—personally and photographically. This may be film, digital, black and white, or color. Is the image technically well produced? Is the composition compelling and original?
- Please provide a return envelope that fits your print and provide postage if you would like your submission returned to you. Submissions will not be returned if there is not the proper amount of postage. Please note if do not want your prints returned to you.
- Fill out the Entry Form and Check List and return with the return envelope, prepaid postage, print, and a brief artist statement.

Schedule

- Submissions to arrive at the museum between February 29, 2008 and March 30th, 2008.
- Jurying process to take place late April – early May 2008.
- Finalists will be notified in early May 2008.

- Finalists work to be delivered framed and matted to the museum prepared for hanging by May 22, 2008.
- The exhibition will take place starting on June 5, 2008 – August 30th, 2008 in the Griffin Gallery. This is the same period during which the selections from the 14th Annual will also be exhibit in the Main Gallery.

The jurors are Andrea Rosenthal and Andrew Kessler of Coffee Pond Productions. The jurors will select, first, the recipient of the *Joan Johnson Scholarship* and then which photographs will be exhibited in the Griffin Gallery of the museum during the exhibition as well as write a jurors' statement on the work..

Goals

- To expand the museum's exposure in the surrounding community.
- To provide an incentive for students to engage in photography and self expression
- To improve student proficiency in image-making and visual art awareness.
- To expose the student to the process of preparing for a professional juried submission.
- To improve student analytical skills in the selection of their best work.
- To encourage students to develop their own personal style in photography
